## Muckla



## About the pattern:

Now, this is my first attempt to translate a pattern into English, so if anything is unclear, please contact me and I'll try to explain better.
This pattern may not be sold, copied or otherwise redistributed without the author's approval. Nor is it permitted to manufacture items made from this pattern to sell. However, you may of course make as many items as you want to give away to friends and loved ones!
If you have any problems with the pattern, please let me know. I'd love to see your "muckla" (I have no idea what they are called in English, if any of you know, please tell me!) when it is finished as well, so please send a picture! Good Luck!

## Materials:

- Yarn in any color and a matching crochet hook (remember to always use a crochet hook that is a little smaller than recommended for the yarn as you crochet amigurumi). I have used cotton yarn Flox from Marks \& Kattens and a 2.5 mm crochet hook
- Safety eyes or yarn to embroider the eyes with
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Needle \& scissors


## Abbrevations:

| st | - | stitch |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| sc | - | single crochet |
| ch | - | chain |
| sl st | - | slip stitch |
| () | - | repeat throughout the round |
| sc2tog | - | single crochet 2 together (decrease by 1 stitch) |
| sc3tog | - | single crochet 3 together (decrease by 2 stitch) |
| sk | - | skip |

## Head:

1. 6sc into magic loop
2. (2sc in each st)
3. (sc1, 2sc in next st)

4-6. sc18
7. (sc2, 2sc in next st)
8. (sc3, 2sc in next st)
9. (sc4, 2sc in next st)

10-14. sc36
If you are using safety eyes, you should probably attach them now.
15. (sc4, sc2tog)
16. (sc3, sc2tog)
17. (sc2, sc2tog)
18. (sc1, sc2tog)
19. (sc2tog)

Stuff the head and pull the stitches together by sewing in the outer bows throughout the round. Fasten off.

## Ears: x2

1.4 sc into magic loop
2. (sc $1,2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st)
3. (sc2, 2sc in next st)
4. (sc2, sc2tog)

Finish off with a sl st. Fasten off leaving long yarn to attach the ears on the head. Sew edges together so the ear gets flat.

## Body:

1. 6sc into magic loop
2. (2sc in each st)
3. (sc 1, 2sc in next st)
4. (sc2, 2sc in next st)
5. (sc3, 2sc in next st)
6. (sc4, 2sc in next st)
7. (sc5, 2sc in next st)
8. (sc6, 2sc in next st)

9-11. sc48
12. (sc6, sc2tog)

13-15. sc42
16. (sc5, sc2tog)

17-19. sc36
20. (sc4, sc2tog)

21-23. sc30
24. (sc3, sc2tog)

25-27. sc24
28. (sc2, sc2tog)

29-31. sc 18
Fasten off leaving long yarn to attach the head onto the body. Stuff body.

## Legs: $\mathbf{x} 2$

1. ch5, sk1, sc3, 3sc in next st, sc2, 2sc in next st

2. 2 sc in next st , sc3, 2 sc in next 2 st , $\mathrm{sc} 3,2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st
3. 2 sc in next st, sc5, 2 sc in next 2 st , sc5, 2 sc in next st
4. 2 sc in next st, sc $7,2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next 2 st , sc7, 2 sc in next st
5. sc8, 2 sc in next 3 st , sc8
6. sc6, sc2tog, sc3tog, sc2tog, sc6
7. sc4, sc2tog, sc3tog, sc2tog, sc4

8-10. sc11
Fasten off leaving long yarn to attach the leg onto the body. Stuff leg.

## Arms: x2

1. 4sc into magic loop
2. (2sc in next st)
3. (sc1,2sc in next st)
4. sc 12

## 5. (sc1, sc2tog)

6-12. sc8
Fasten off leaving long yarn to attach arm onto body. Use the backside of a crochet hook or pencil to put a bit of stuffing in the hand, sew edges together.

## Tail:

1. 4sc into magic loop
(4)
2. (sc $1,2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st)
(6)
3. (sc2, 2sc in next st)
4. (sc3, 2sc in next st)
5. (sc4, 2sc in next st)
6. (sc5, 2sc in next st)

Fasten off leaving long yarn to attach tail onto body. Stuff tail while attaching to body
